

Resolution on Island Access Rules

To protect island residents and the Common Assets, to ensure compliance with island access rules, and to identify persons in case of an emergency, Security Officers may require any person seeking entrance to or already on Harbor Island to provide identification such as a driver's license or other ID document showing the person's name and contact information, vehicle registration and insurance coverage, work orders, delivery orders, and car passes or decals.

In case of renters, Security may require a copy of the rental contract or other rental document stating the names of the owner, renters or the point of contact for groups of renters, and the rental agent; the address of the rented property; and the duration of the renter's stay. Rental owners and rental agencies are responsible for notifying tenants of this requirement to avoid delay in their being admitted to Harbor Island.

Security may copy those documents other than the driver's license and credit card numbers and may record pertinent information from the license. Any person who refuses to provide that information may be denied entrance to, or be expelled from, Harbor Island.
