



I am in process of closing a legal practice in Nashville, Tennessee. Before that, I was a banker in New York, Montreal and Toronto. I have a Bachelor's degree from the University of Pennsylvania, a Master's in Business Administration from the University of Chicago and a law degree from Vanderbilt.

Harbor Island is not just beautiful. It is also a business enterprise in its own right. It is a community in which we each have invested hundreds of thousands of dollars. Keeping this a special place, making sure that the business of Harbor Island runs smoothly and supporting our homes' values – all require an effective management team as well as a strong Board of Directors.
